Event/Project Name: Fundraising/ Events committee

Event/Project Description: - Works with Opening Day committee, Picture night, Home Run Derby, Coin Drops, End of Season banquet

INFORMATION ON COIN DROPS:

Event/Project Name: Grocery Store coin drop (fundraising event)

Event/Project Description: This very easy event which involves an adult or two and no more than 4 children. The idea is to stand outside Stop and Shop or any other supermarket/ big name store and ask people for donations.

Amount of time devoted and when : 1 to 2 hours calling and getting a date from the store manager, 1 day to plan the times that teams will take turns, 6 to 8 hours to actually be at the stores.

Amount of people needed to complete project: if done the right way, you need one organizer to setup the date and then 8 adults (doing 4 two hour shifts) and then 16 kids also doing 4 two hour shifts.

Players should come wearing their uniform tops at least.

Costs involved in your project/event: 5 to 15 dollars to make up signs for the day of the event. Need a water jug if no has one to lend or borrow.

Timing of your event/project:

Before the season is a great time, everyone is excited again about baseball.

On a weekend, of course to generate the most business.

Notes: in previous years we we collected around 400 dollars in one day outside of Stop and Shop. We also sold raffle tickets from the Lion's club which helped to generate some buzz. We also did a coin drop in conjunction with Kiss FM and collected 600 for the HR derby.
