UIC Position

Position Name: Umpire-in-Chief (UIC)

Description: The Umpire-in-Chief shall:

- (a) Be responsible for securing adequate umpires for the Poughkeepsie Baseball BR/CR Majors/Minors program (ages 9-12). Shall interview candidates and present to the President, a list of prospective umpires, for his approval;
- (b) Be responsible for umpire training and instruction in accordance with Babe Ruth/Cal Ripken and Poughkeepsie Baseball BR/CR local rules and policies;
- (c) Be responsible to the President of Poughkeepsie Baseball BR/CR for the conduct of all umpires;
- (d) Be responsible for drafting the Poughkeepsie Baseball BR/CR local rules and policies, chairing the league's Umpire Committee, and presenting the rules and policies the Committee agreed upon for full BOD approval;
- (e) Submit to the President for his approval, the fee schedule for game fees, for full BOD approval;
- (f) Submit to the league equipment manager, a list of umpire equipment needs;
- (g) Communicate Babe Ruth/Cal Ripken League rules and rule changes to the President and to the team managers;
- (h) Participate as the league representative at any/all meetings at district level when rules are discussed;
- (i) Schedule umpires for all Major/Minor games;
- (j) Chair the protest committee;
- (k) Shall not manage a team while holding this position.

Amount of time devoted and when: This position is active the entire year. Generally, it's 10 hrs per week.

Costs involved in this project/event: Preparing handouts for umpire training runs about \$100 per year
