### Committee/Event leader fact sheet

**Event/Project Name:** Tournament Committee

**Event/Project Description:** The league enters teams in non-All Star tournaments, usually at the Minors/Majors/15u levels. Some tournaments repeat every year, such as the “Vito”, “Castellano”, “Lamondo”, “Marlboro” tournaments. This committee, especially the leader, should act as the focal point for all tournaments and understand cost, the players involved, dates/times, etc. Any manager that wants to enter a team in a tournament **MUST** go through the Leader first. The Leader reports back to the Board and keeps the Board apprised of everything that is going on with tournaments. In 2009 we played in five such tournaments (not including All Stars). For tournaments we typically enter, if there is no manager initially volunteers to run the team, attempt to find a manager. Be pro-active.

**Amount of time devoted and when:** 4-5 hours spent on phone calls and emails and general coordination, usually in June/July/August.

**Amount of people needed to complete project:** 1

**Costs involved in your project/event:** Usually nothing, parents will fund the entry fee and all costs (such as uniforms, etc.).

**Notes:** stay on top of everything, make sure managers do not act on their own.
