Committee/Event leader fact sheet

Event/Project Name: Winter Clinic

Event/Project Description: Conduct a Winter Baseball Clinic to give kids a head start for the spring season. Usually for ages 7-11. You can have a rotational instructional one week, minors the next week and majors the last week. In the past we have partnered with Extra Innings where they provided the instructors and facility. This can/should be used as a fundraiser event. Committee Leader should get parent volunteers to work stations.

Amount of time devoted and when:

Committee lead:

Oct – Nov about 1 hr per week. (setting up clinic)

Nov-Dec About 2 hrs per week. (registration processing)

Jan – March 2 hrs per week. (this was split up so I didn't have to be there every week.)

Age group Lead:

Jan – March 3 hrs every 3rd week.

Parent volunteer:

Jan – March 2 hrs every 3rd week.

Amount of people needed to complete project: 1 Lead for the program, 1 lead for each age group, 4-5 parent volunteers to help run stations.

Costs involved in your project/event: depends on the fee that Extra Innings or another partner will charge. In 2009 the fee was \$1300 and the profit was \$1000.

Notes: In Spring 2009 the program sold out in all divisions except Rookie division. Consensus was this was priced too low for the level of instruction. Lot of parents had excellent comments. Extra innings is also a team and Sign sponsor.
